Safeguarding Policies

Photography Policy

This policy applies to all persons and to all types of photography equipment, including those within 'smart' devices such as tablets and mobile phones.



Tees Active Ltd, the facility provider at Thornaby Pool, Splash and Billingham Forum, in their Operating Procedures (6.8), state:

"Tees Active Limited has introduced a Photographic Policy, which prohibits the use of photographic equipment within a Tees Active Limited facility - unless Management consent has been given, in accordance with the requirements of the said Policy. The Policy is available for staff reference in the Duty Manager Office"

In view of this, Club members, parents and other persons connected with Club members **must not** take 'still' or 'video' photographic images of any person within the Pool buildings.

It is also very likely that operators of other pools that Thornaby ASC visit (e.g. for competitive purposes) will prohibit the use of photography. It is essential for all to ensure that operating procedures of any facility are observed in order to provide adequate safeguarding for all.

Thornaby ASC has appointed an official photographer for Club Gala events, who will observe best practice in relation to ASA Wavepower policy. Prints will be available for purchase in the weeks following the event.

Parents have the right to refuse the capture of such photography and must states this on their Club Membership Form or inform a Club official immediately.

Thornaby Amateur Swimming Club adopts the ASA Wavepower framework in order to adhere to Safeguarding Guidelines. Your support and co-operation in following this policy is greatly appreciated.
